

FOOD & NUTRITION SERVICES

Food & Nutrition Services, a federally funded program, are used to supplement the food needs of individuals. This program helps our customers to become self-sufficient as it is a supplement for those not working or who are in transition to the job force.

The Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) Program became available in April, 1999 as a means of replacement for food stamp coupons. EBT Cards look and function like a bank debit card or check card. Customers may contact E-Funds on a designated monthly date in order to verify FNS deposits. Clients access Point of Sale (POS) machines made available by various grocery stores in order to make food purchases. The result is an immediate reduction of account funds and customers know, based on store receipts, their remaining balances for future purchases.
